Her scientific interests focus on clinical and experimental endocrinology.

She is an advocate for true and extensive cooperation among endocrinologists and other medical disciplines. This idea of a holistic approach to the patient is implemented, among others, by: encouraging the cooperation of neuroendocrine tumor (NET) specialists to accelerate the rapid development of this discipline.

She is President of The Polish Society of Endocrinology and a member of the Advisory Board of the European Neuroendocrine Tumor Society (ENETS).

She was also served as a member of the Executive Committee of ESE and ENETS.

She founded the Polish Network of Neuroendocrine Tumors and the Polish National Register of NETs; she currently serves as Chair of both.

She has published over 500 publications in Polish and foreign medical journals, textbooks and numerous communications from international and national conferences. She is an active participant in the work of many national and international scientific societies and organizer of numerous scientific congresses.
